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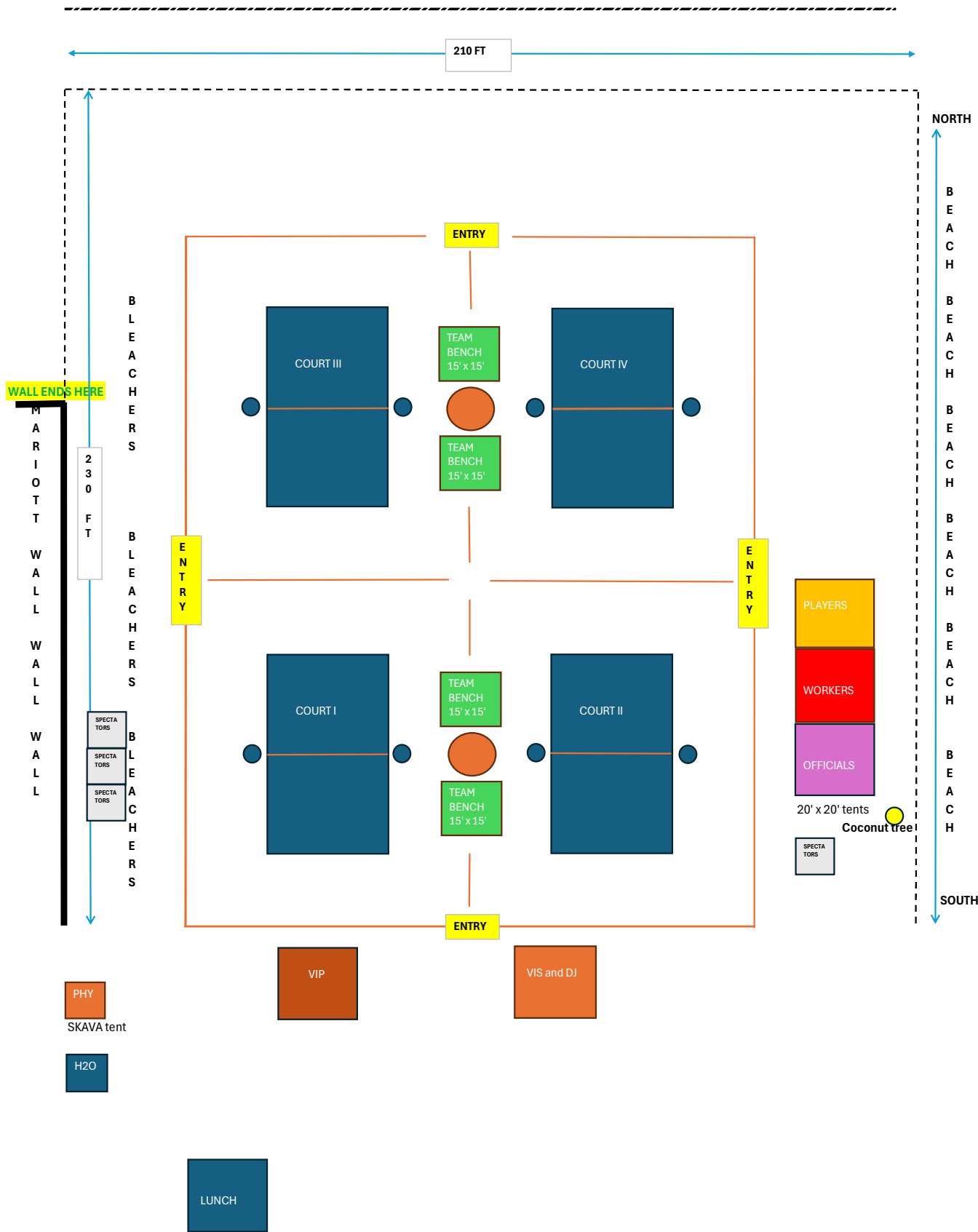

Dominica, St. Kitts & Nevis, Grenada, and St. Lucia Headed to ECVA U21 Beach Volleyball Men's Semifinals



BASSETTERRE, St. Kitts & Nevis, June 7, 2025.- Despite intermittent rain and strong winds, Defending champions Mervin Mingo/Bill Frederick of Dominica, Jedediah Pencheon/Vikash Sundar of St. Kitts and Nevis, Grenada's Walcott Zerick/Kibose Hamilton, along with St. Lucia's Victor Rio and Peter Emmanuel, emerged as the top four men's teams of the 2025 ECVA U21 Beach Volleyball Championship.

Sunday's semifinals will see Jedediah Pencheon and Vikash Sundar of St. Kitts and Nevis face Victor Rio and Peter Emmanuel of St. Lucia, while Dominica's Mervin

Mingo and Bill Frederick take on Walcott Zerick and Kibose Hamilton of Grenada.

Sundar/Pencheon of St. Kitts and Nevis thrilled the home crowd with a commanding performance, defeating Antigua and Barbuda's Khaliq Joseph and Miguel Lugo in straight sets, 2-0 (22-20, 21-13), in the quarterfinals.

Dominica's Mingo/Frederick delivered a powerful performance in their quarterfinal match, defeating Alex Lall and Joash Walters of St. Kitts and Nevis in straight sets, 2-0 (21-17, 21-7). After a competitive first set, the Dominican duo tightened their grip on the match, dominating the second set with a decisive scoreline to advance to the semifinals.

Zerick and Hamilton of Grenada showed composure and consistency throughout the quarterfinal clash, earning their spot in the semifinals with a 2-0 (21-19, 21-16) victory over the British Virgin Islands duo, Maduro Dunkley and Alexander Wheatley.

Finally, St. Lucia's team Rio/Emmanuel clinched the last spot in the semifinals with a composed and efficient 2-0 (21-17, 21-17) victory over Julian Bristol and Komarr Fraties of St. Kitts and Nevis, sealing their place among the tournament's top four teams.

Earlier in the day, in the Round of 12, Lugo/Joseph of Antigua and Barbuda dominated D'jario Hassell/De Jesus of Sint Eustatius with a commanding 2-0 win (21-10, 21-10). Mingo/Frederick of Dominica also secured a straight-set victory, defeating Bermuda's Dos Santos Martin/Mello Kyle Mello 2-0 (21-11, 21-9).

Bristol/Fraties from St. Kitts and Nevis overpowered Smith/Reid of Anguilla, also with a 2-0 score (21-12, 21-12). In a more competitive encounter, Maduro Dunkley/Maduro/Wheatley of the British Virgin Islands edged past Alexander/Stephen from St. Vincent and the Grenadines in three sets, 2-1 (21-16, 19-21, 15-10).

Antigua, Anguilla, St. Lucia, and Dominica Reach Women's Final Four at ECVA U21 Beach Volleyball



BASSETERRE, St. Kitts & Nevis, June 7, 2025.- The duos of Jassania Joseph/Jaya Carr of Antigua and Barbuda, Deandra Fleming/Lavesha Richardson of Anguilla, St. Lucia's Ericka Gaspard/Clio Phillip and Dominica's Alyssa Bully/Joyan Pascal are the final four women's teams at the 2025 ECVA U21 Beach Volleyball Championship being held in St. Kitts and Nevis.

Sunday's semifinal matchups will see Jassania Joseph and Jaya Carr of Antigua and Barbuda go head-to-head with Dominica's Alyssa Bully and Joyan Pascal, while St. Lucia's Ericka Gaspard and Clio Phillip will clash with Deandra

Fleming and Lavesha Richardson of Anguilla for a place in the championship final.

Joseph/Carr of Antigua and Barbuda overcame a slow start and battled through rain and strong winds to claim a hard-fought 2-1 (18-21, 21-15, 15-12) victory over Bermuda's Kayley Hamilton and Hailey Moss. Despite losing the opening set, the Antiguan pair adjusted their game and showed resilience under the challenging weather conditions to secure the win.

Richardson and Fleming of Anguilla advanced to the semifinals with a straight-sets victory over Gereliva Spanner and Gercia Brown of St. Eustatius, winning 2-0 (21-14, 21-11) in the quarterfinals

St. Lucia's Phillip/Ericka delivered a dominant performance in the quarterfinals, displaying confidence to overpower the home team of Celina Awlani and Hensley Phillip 2-0 (21-12, 21-6).

Dominica's Bully and Pascal delivered a solid performance in the final quarterfinal match of the day. The duo secured a straight-set victory over Grenada's Xenia Collins and Teasia Jones, winning 2-0 (21-14, 21-12) to punch their ticket to the semifinals.

In the Round of 12, Awlani/Hensley Phillip of St. Kitts and Nevis (SKN) claimed a straight-set victory over Dryaton/Farington of the British Virgin Islands 2-0 (21-19, 21-11). Teasia and Collins of Grenada edged out Amritt/Pinney from SKN in a tightly contested match, winning 2-1 (21-9, 18-21, 16-14). Spanner and Brown of Sint Eustatius cruised past Andrew/Campbell, also from SKN, with a convincing 2-0 (21-7, 21-15). Meanwhile, Joseph/Carr from Antigua and Barbuda bounced back after dropping the first set to defeat Gibson/Matthews of Saint Vincent and the Grenadines 2-1 (21-23, 21-6, 15-10).

Antigua, Anguila, Santa Lucía y Dominica avanzan al Final Four Femenino ECVA U21 Voleibol de Playa



BASSETERRE, St. Kitts & Nevis, 7 de junio de 2025.- Las duplas de Jassania Joseph/Jaya Carr de Antigua y Barbuda, Deandra Fleming/Lavesha Richardson de Anguila, Ericka Gaspard/Clio Phillip de Santa Lucía y Alyssa Bully/Joyan Pascal de Dominica son los cuatro equipos femeninos finalistas del Campeonato ECVA U21 de Voleibol de Playa 2025, que se disputa en San Cristóbal y Nieves.

Las semifinales del domingo enfrentarán a Jassania Joseph y Jaya Carr de Antigua y Barbuda contra Alyssa Bully y Joyan Pascal de Dominica, mientras que Ericka Gaspard y Clio Phillip de Santa Lucía se medirán ante Deandra Fleming y

Lavesha Richardson de Anguila por un pase a la gran final del campeonato.

Joseph/Carr de Antigua y Barbuda se recuperaron tras un inicio lento y lucharon contra la lluvia y los fuertes vientos para conseguir una victoria trabajada por 2-1 (18-21, 21-15, 15-12) sobre Kayley Hamilton y Hailey Moss de Bermudas. A pesar de perder el primer set, la dupla antiguëña ajustó su juego y mostró resiliencia ante las difíciles condiciones climáticas para quedarse con el triunfo.

Richardson y Fleming de Anguila avanzaron a semifinales tras una victoria en sets corridos sobre Gereliva Spanner y Gercia Brown de San Eustaquio, con marcador de 2-0 (21-14, 21-11) en los cuartos de final.

Dominica, San Cristóbal & Nieves, Granada y Santa Lucía avanzan a las semifinales ECVA U21 Voleibol de Playa Masculino



BASSETERRE, San Cristóbal y Nieves, 7 de junio de 2025. - A pesar de la lluvia intermitente y los fuertes vientos, los campeones defensores Mervin Mingo/Bill Frederick de Dominica, Jedediah Pencheon/Vikash Sundar de San Cristóbal y Nieves, Walcott Zerick/Kibose Hamilton de Granada y Victor Rio/Peter Emmanuel de Santa Lucía se consolidaron como los cuatro mejores equipos masculinos del Campeonato U21 de Voleibol de Playa ECVA 2025.

Las semifinales del domingo enfrentarán a Jedediah Pencheon y Vikash Sundar de San Cristóbal y Nieves contra Victor Rio y Peter Emmanuel de Santa Lucía, mientras que Mervin Mingo y Bill Frederick de Dominica se medirán ante Walcott Zerick y Kibose Hamilton de Granada.

Sundar/Pencheon de San Cristóbal y Nieves emocionaron al público local con una actuación dominante, venciendo en sets corridos a Khaliq Joseph y Miguel Lugo de Antigua y Barbuda, 2-0 (22-20, 21-13), en los cuartos de final.

La dupla Mingo/Frederick de Dominica ofreció una actuación contundente en su partido de cuartos de final, derrotando a Alex Lall y Joash Walters de San Cristóbal y Nieves en sets corridos, 2-0 (21-17, 21-7). Tras un primer set competitivo, los de Dominica tomaron el control total del partido, dominando el segundo set con claridad para asegurar su pase a semifinales.

Zerick y Hamilton de Granada mostraron aplomo y consistencia a lo largo de su duelo de cuartos de final, ganándose un lugar en semifinales con una victoria 2-0 (21-19, 21-16) sobre la dupla de las Islas Vírgenes Británicas, Maduro Dunkley y Alexander Wheatley.

En un duelo más reñido, Maduro Dunkley/Wheatley de las Islas Vírgenes Británicas se impusieron en tres sets a Alexander/Stephen de San Vicente y las Granadinas, 2-1 (21-16, 19-21, 15-10).
