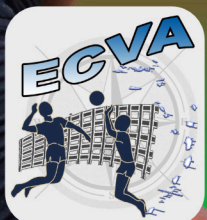

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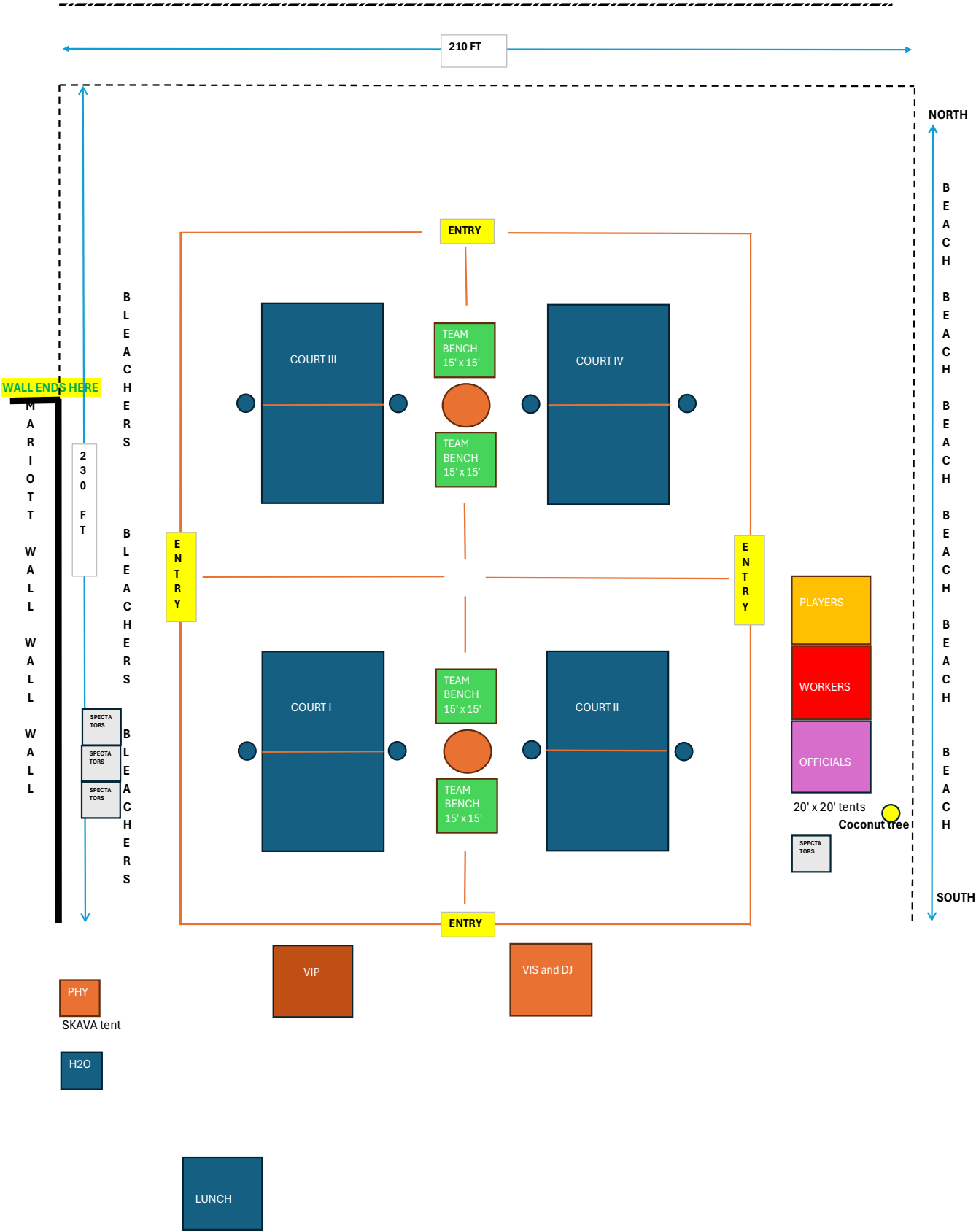

Dominica's Mingo and Frederick Defend ECVA U21 Men's Title with Back-to-Back Gold



BASSETERRE, St. Kitts & Nevis, June 8, 2025.- Dominica's Mervin Mingo and Bill Frederick were crowned ECVA U21 Men's Beach Volleyball Champions for the second year in a row, delivering a confident 2-0 win (21-17, 21-15) over St. Lucia's Victor Rio and Peter Emmanuel in Sunday's gold medal match at the scenic shores of Saint Kitts and Nevis.

The Dominican duo reaffirmed their dominance in the region with another stellar performance, despite going through the round of 12 after finishing second in Pool A of the preliminary round, coincidentally losing to St. Lucia's duo Rio/Emmanuel.

In the championship match, Mingo and Frederick displayed control, keeping their composure under pressure and dictating the pace of the match. Their consistency and experience proved too much for the St. Lucian team, who fought hard but couldn't break through.

Speaking after winning the gold medal, Frederick said "We feel very excited, because it's another accomplishment in our books and I can't even explain it, I am flabbergasted".

Mervin Mingo added a warm thank you to their parents, coaches and fans "their support was very important for us".

In an exciting bronze medal match, Grenada's Walcott Zerick and Kibose Hamilton battled past home favorites Jedediah Pencheon and Vikash Sundar of St. Kitts and Nevis in a thrilling 2-1 victory (21-17, 12-21, 15-11). After taking the opening set, Zerick and Hamilton faced a fierce response in the second but regrouped with determination to seal the deciding set and claim the bronze medal.

The top three finishers of the event move on to represent the Eastern Caribbean Volleyball Association (ECVA) at the NORCECA World Championships Qualifier Tournament.

Mervin Mingo and Bill Frederick of Dominica took a confident step toward back-to-back titles with a straight-sets semifinal victory 2-0 (21-18, 21-15) against Grenada's Walcott Zerick and Kibose Hamilton. The Dominican pair showcased their experience and composure in key moments.

St. Lucia's duo, Rio/Emmanuel, secured a swift and convincing 2-0 (21-11, 21-11) victory in their semifinal match against the home team of Sundar and Puncheon. They took both sets by comfortable margins, while Rio was particularly effective at the net, consistently shutting down St. Kitts' scoring efforts.

Mingo y Frederick de Dominica revalidan título ECVA U21 Masculino con oro consecutivo



BASSETTERRE, San Cristóbal y Nieves, 8 de junio de 2025.-

Mervin Mingo y Bill Frederick de Dominica se coronaron campeones del torneo U21 masculino de voleibol de playa de ECVA por segundo año consecutivo, tras vencer con autoridad 2-0 (21-17, 21-15) a la dupla de Santa Lucía, Victor Rio y Peter Emmanuel, en la final disputada este domingo en las hermosas playas de San Cristóbal y Nieves.

La dupla de Dominica reafirmó su dominio en la región con otra destacada actuación, a pesar de haber tenido que disputar la ronda de 12 tras quedar segundos en el Grupo A de la fase preliminar, donde curiosamente cayeron ante la misma dupla de Santa Lucía (Rio/Emmanuel).

En la final, Mingo y Frederick demostraron control total, manteniendo la compostura bajo presión y marcando el ritmo del partido. Su consistencia y experiencia fueron demasiado para el equipo de Santa Lucía, que luchó fuertemente, pero no logró superarlos.

Tras ganar la medalla de oro, Frederick expresó: “Nos sentimos muy emocionados, porque es otro logro más en nuestra trayectoria y ni siquiera puedo explicarlo, estoy asombrado”.

Mervin Mingo agregó un cálido agradecimiento a sus padres, entrenadores y aficionados: “Su apoyo fue muy importante para nosotros”.

En un emocionante partido por el bronce, Walcott Zerick y Kibose Hamilton de Granada superaron a los locales Jedediah Pencheon y Vikash Sundar de San Cristóbal y Nieves en una vibrante victoria 2-1 (21-17, 12-21, 15-11). Tras llevarse el primer set, Zerick y Hamilton enfrentaron una fuerte reacción en el segundo, pero se reagruparon con determinación para asegurar el set decisivo y quedarse con la medalla de bronce.

Los tres primeros lugares del evento representarán a la Asociación de Voleibol del Caribe Este (ECVA) en el Torneo NORCECA Clasificatorio al Campeonato Mundial.

Mervin Mingo y Bill Frederick de Dominica dieron un paso firme hacia su segundo título consecutivo con una victoria en semifinales por 2-0 (21-18, 21-15) frente a Walcott Zerick y Kibose Hamilton de Granada. La dupla de Dominica mostró experiencia y temple en los momentos clave.

Ambos sets fueron dominados por Santa Lucía, con Rio especialmente efectivo en la red, bloqueando constantemente los intentos ofensivos de San Cristóbal y Nieves.

St. Lucia's Phillip and Ericka Crowned Undefeated ECVA U21 Women's Champions



BASSETERRE, St. Kitts & Nevis, June 8, 2025. - St. Lucia's Ericka Gaspard and Clio Phillip delivered a flawless performance at the ECVA U21 Beach Volleyball Championship, capturing the women's gold medal with an undefeated 5-0 record and without dropping a single set.

In the final, Phillip and Ericka overpowered Antigua and Barbuda's Jassania Joseph and Jaya Carr in straight sets, 2-0 (21-11, 23-21), sealing their championship run in dominant fashion on the sands of Saint Kitts and Nevis.

The St. Lucian duo controlled the opening set with authority but had to dig deep in the second after trailing 19-20. With calm under pressure and sharp execution, Phillip and Ericka

rallied to close the match 23-21, completing their perfect tournament and claiming the gold medal.

In an interview after the victory, Phillip said "We feel great, we are excited, we are happy. This is what we came to do, win the Gold!"

Speaking about the match, Ericka said "We really had to work hard in the last set. Our confidence allowed us to push through the last points".

Dominica's Alyssa Bully and Joyan Pascal secured an exciting bronze medal victory in three sets over Anguilla's Deandra Fleming and Lavesha Richardson. Bully/Pascal came out strong to take the first set 21-14, but Fleming/Richardson fought back in a tight second set, edging it 22-20 to force a decider. In the third, Bully and Pascal regained control with a dominant 15-7 finish to clinch the 2-1 win and a spot on the podium.

The top three finishers of the event move on to represent the Eastern Caribbean Volleyball Association (ECVA) at the NORCECA World Championships Qualifier Tournament.

St. Lucia's Ericka/Phillip advanced to the championship match, with consistent play, to earn a straight-set 2-0 (21-16, 21-17) victory over Deandra Fleming and Lavesha Richardson of Anguilla.

In a hard-fought semifinal, Joseph and Carr edged Dominica's Bully and Pascal 2-1 (21-12, 15-21, 15-12). After splitting the first two sets, Joseph and Carr led 13-9 in the decider before withstanding a late Dominican rally to secure their spot in the final.

Phillip y Ericka de Santa Lucía se coronan campeonas invictas ECVA U21



BASSETERRE, San Cristóbal y Nieves, 8 de junio de 2025.- Ericka Gaspard y Clio Phillip de Santa Lucía realizaron una actuación impecable en el Campeonato U21 de Voleibol de Playa de ECVA, llevándose la medalla de oro femenina con un récord perfecto de 5-0 y sin ceder un solo set.

En la final, Phillip y Ericka superaron con autoridad a la dupla de Antigua y Barbuda conformada por Jassania Joseph y Jaya Carr, con un triunfo en sets corridos 2-0 (21-11, 23-21), coronándose campeonas de forma dominante en las arenas de San Cristóbal y Nieves.

La dupla de Santa Lucía controló con contundencia el primer set, pero tuvo que esforzarse al máximo en el segundo tras ir abajo 19-20. Con sangre fría y una ejecución precisa, Phillip y Ericka remontaron para cerrar el partido 23-21, completando un torneo perfecto y llevándose el oro.

En entrevista tras la victoria, Phillip comentó: “Nos sentimos increíbles, emocionadas, felices. ¡Vinimos a esto, a ganar el oro!”

Por su parte, Ericka agregó: “Tuvimos que trabajar muy duro en el último set. Nuestra confianza nos permitió sacar los últimos puntos”.

La medalla de bronce fue para Alyssa Bully y Joyan Pascal de Dominica, quienes vencieron en un emocionante partido a tres sets a Deandra Fleming y Lavesha Richardson de Anguila. Bully y Pascal arrancaron con fuerza ganando el primer set 21-14, pero Fleming y Richardson reaccionaron para llevarse el segundo 22-20 y forzar el desempate. En el set decisivo, la dupla de Dominica retomó el control con un claro 15-7 para cerrar el 2-1 y subir al podio.

Los tres primeros lugares del evento representarán a la Asociación de Voleibol del Caribe Este (ECVA) en el Torneo NORCECA Clasificatorio al Campeonato Mundial.

Ericka y Phillip de Santa Lucía avanzaron a la final con un triunfo sólido en semifinales por 2-0 (21-16, 21-17) frente a Deandra Fleming y Lavesha Richardson de Anguila.

En una intensa semifinal, Joseph y Carr derrotaron a Bully y Pascal de Dominica 2-1 (21-12, 15-21, 15-12). Tras dividir los dos primeros sets, Joseph y Carr tomaron ventaja 13-9 en el tercero y resistieron una remontada final para asegurar su pase a la final.
