- IN 2025, the ECVA Referee Commission has organized Virtual Referee Clinics via the MS Teams environment to ensure assigned referees arrive better prepared to officiate in tournaments.
- This was introduced because having a clinic locally before the tournament begins is not feasible due to time constraints
- The virtual clinic was also conducted before the VB Senior Tournaments and was conducted by R. Willemsberg and B. Charles.

8. Challenges

- Although the registration of referees has improved, we still see that some NFs are not in full compliance. This takes away the opportunity for regional national referees to be eligible to participate in international VB/BVB referee courses.
- Since 2023, the referee commission has ensured that all referees participating in the tournaments are registered by reviewing the submitted R-1 forms. In case the referee is not registered, the respective NFs are contacted to rectify the situation. (See the next slide for a copy of registered referees who have participated in the tournaments in 2023 and 2024.)
- Not enough development possibilities for the region
- Lack of initiative by the individual referees to keep up with the theory
- Lack of practical experience in active IRs, Continental IRs, and Continental IRCs.
- Not enough chances for ECVA referees to be able to work in tournaments.
 - This can be improved with referee/referee coach exchanges between zones ECVA and CAZOVA
- Challenge for succession ECVA Referee Commission.
- Local Referee Participation: local referees often face additional burdens and distractions when not fully integrated into tournament accommodations, impacting their focus and the sense of team cohesion.

10. Evaluation Referees

- Referees demonstrated growth and eagerness to learn
- Continued preparation and structured training are essential
- ECVA Referee Commission should prioritize clinics and mentorship to build consistency and confidence



11. Recommendations

- Referees should participate in virtual and practical clinics
- Referees should focus on confidence, decisiveness, and proper signaling
- Continuous Study and Application: Referees are urged to continue reviewing the latest rule book, guidelines, and case studies, emphasizing that understanding and correctly interpreting the official materials is crucial for effective officiating.
- Knowledge Sharing and Mentorship: Referees are encouraged to pass on their experiences and insights to colleagues, players, and coaches, fostering a more informed volleyball community and supporting the development of future referees.
- Setting Aspirations and Succession Planning: Referees are advised to set high
 goals, such as aiming for continental or international certification, and to step
 aside or mentor others if they are no longer eligible for advancement, ensuring the
 growth of the referee pool.



11. Recommendations continued

- Self-Analysis and Constructive Criticism: the importance of self-analysis of referees and accepting constructive criticism, recommending that referees engage in post-match reviews and discussions to identify strengths and areas for improvement.
- Per Diem: National federations have to adhere per diem as stated in the tournament regulations
- Local Referee Participation: National federations are urged to ensure that the local referees are integrated into tournament accommodations, resulting in improved focus and team cohesion.
- Early arrival of referees before the start of the tournament should be continued because it makes it possible to have face to face clinics and practical sessions to help hone the skills of the referees
- Maintaining a Consistent Referee Pool: ECVA should continue to work with a stable group of referees, rotating them across tournaments to build experience
